



Navy Yard Parking News

Dear Friends & Neighbors,

After discussions between FCNY, Boston City Councilor Sal LaMattina and the Boston Transportation Department, a resident parking program will be implemented in the Yard. Starting on July 29th, there will be a two-hour limit placed on non-resident parking every day between the hours of 8AM to 8PM on certain spots on First Avenue and Eighth Street that are controlled by the City. The parking plan addresses a community-wide concern that out of town commuters have been using up scarce parking spaces, either while working downtown or while away on travel. It also means that anyone who wishes to park long-term during those hours will need to obtain a resident parking sticker. For information on how to obtain a sticker visit
